

# Exemplar

## Acceptance criteria

- From a podcast page, the user can tap a heart to mark it as a favourite quickly and easily.
- Favoured podcasts show up in a favourites area so they are easier to find later.
- If there's no internet, it should still work somehow or try again soon.
- Pressing the heart again should remove it from favourites.
- The app should look normal while this happens and not be confusing.

## User story

As a **Spotify podcast listener** who uses the app in many situations, I want the ability to **mark any podcast as a favourite** in the app so that I can **find it again later without hunting around or searching all the time across different parts of the app, especially when I have lots of shows saved already**.

## User story – Rubric match

User Story Look-fors 	Developing	Proficient	Advanced
<b>Clear user need (who / what / why)</b>		Uses “As a... I want... so that...” with a clear user and benefit.	
<b>Clear order and layout</b>	Story and acceptance criteria are mixed together or hard to follow.		
<b>Short and easy to read</b>	Wordy or unclear; grammar issues get in the way.		

## Acceptance Criteria – Rubric Match

Acceptance Criteria Look-fors 	Developing	Proficient	Advanced
<b>Given/When/Then, testability</b>	Vague steps; not in Given/When/Then; hard to test.		
<b>Specific and measurable details</b>	Uses fuzzy words like “fast” or “easy.”		
<b>Right for the audience and purpose</b>		Scenarios match the intended user and purpose.	
<b>Correct terms and format</b>	Misuses or skips key terms/format.		

### NOTE

This exemplar mixes order (criteria given first), avoids Given/When/Then, and uses vague wording—so it lands as **Developing** overall while still showing a few **Proficient** elements.
